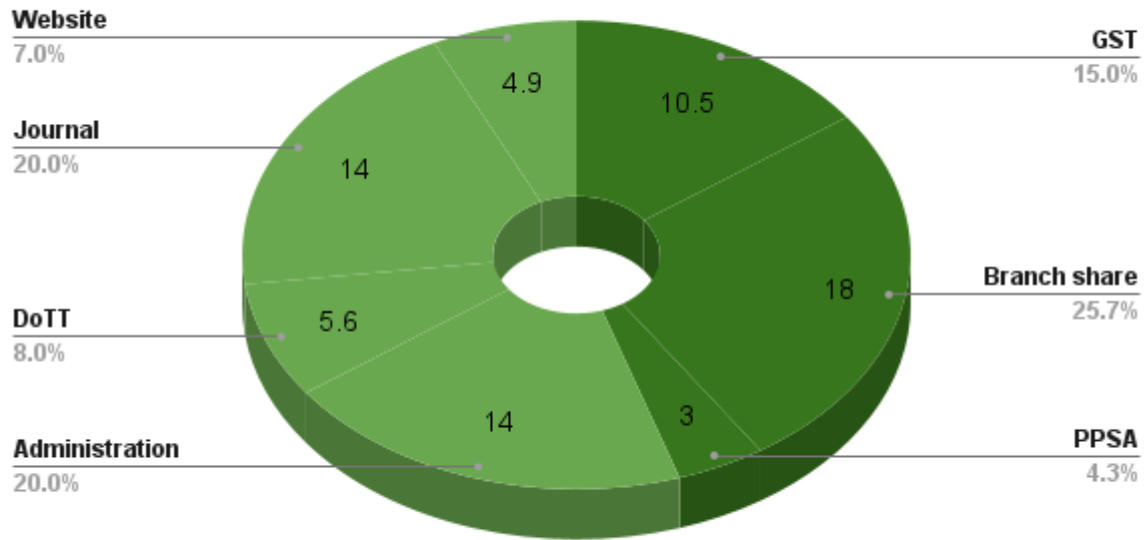
Where does my subscription go? This is question we hear from both parents and teachers. Here below are some answers, in pie-chart format. A proportion of each family's subscription is paid to their branch to help fund branch activities. There are two part-time paid positions with the NZSI, the Administrator and the Director of Teacher Training. Apart from specific contract work (for example, journal production, website development), the rest of the day-to-day running of the NZSI is done by a huge team of volunteer parents and teachers, who organise the workshops, camps, concerts, attend branch, national and international meetings, to name just a few of their many tasks.

Owing to increases in operating costs, the National Executive recommends an \$5 increase to the Family and Teacher subscription from 1 April 2023. The new recommended fees are \$75 for families and \$105 for teachers. The following motion was passed at the NZSI National executive meeting on 29 May 2022: **Motion 2:** The NZSI National Executive recommends that at the 2022 NZSI AGM the

membership fee for the year beginning in April 2023 be increased by \$5 for teachers and \$5 for families, preserving the existing early payment discounts.
