Course Fees: \$500 (refresher course fee is \$250)

An \$100 deposit is required by Friday 4 April to secure your spot

Training Course:

Unit 2 covers; the detailed study and analysis of the development of technique and musicianship through the repertoire in Suzuki Piano Book 2.

Dates and Hours:

Unit 2 consists of 16 hours of teacher training plus 8 hours of documented observations.

Deadline for registration, deposit and course fees:

To secure a place in this course, registration and a non-refundable deposit of \$100 is due on **Friday 4 April**. The remaining fee is due by Friday 18 April. Any late enrolments after the Friday 18 April will be accepted at the discretion of NZSI and may incur a \$20 late fee. If the course is cancelled the \$100 deposit will be refunded in full.

The administrator will send an invoice on receipt of your enrolment.

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PIANO Unit 2 REQUIREMENTS

Attendance Requirements:

Trainees must attend all online and in-person training sessions plus observation sessions. To complete the course and receive the accreditation, non-attendance at a particular session cannot be waived or made up during the course and trainees must stay for the whole session.

Prerequisites for Unit 2:

- Trainees will have memorized all the pieces in Suzuki Piano Book 2.
- Unit 1B must be completed before taking Unit 2.
- Each trainee must be a current **teacher** member of the New Zealand Suzuki Institute. Please email our administrator to begin this process: admin@suzuki.org.nz.

Refresher Course:

NZSI Registered teacher's may enrol in a unit of training that they have taken previously as a 'refresher'. All prerequisites and requirements of the course must be observed with the exception of the written work requirement which may be waived. Participation will be recognised as 'refresher' training and entered into the teacher's training record.

Cancellation Policy:

If minimum enrolment numbers are not met and the course does not run, enrolment fees will be refunded in full. A refund, less an administration fee, will be made if an enrolment is cancelled prior to the enrolment deadline. All cancellations after the enrolment deadline are at the discretion of NZSI.
