

NZSI Training & Assessment Process



When you have been accepted into the NZSI Teacher Training Programme

You can apply to do a unit of training in the instrument you have been accepted on.
Training units are advertised in the teacher newsletter, on the website, by your trainer and also via email.

The teacher training programme covers four levels. Each level consists of two or three units of training with most units corresponding to the Suzuki repertoire book to which it refers (ie. Unit 4 explores Volume 4).
At the end of each Level of training, teachers sit an assessment.
